Dear Parents

I would like to make it clear that the funding for this work has not come out of the school's budget. There is a separate capital fund which is used for building work. Over the summer this fund is also being used to pay for a new ceiling and lights in the school hall and to completely renovate the Foundation Stage and Key Stage 1 toilet blocks.
