## **NEWSLETTER**

Dear Parents

The half term holiday is upon us. Please remember that the school is closed for one week and a day. The children return to school on Tuesday 4<sup>th</sup> November. This week the Autumn has really arrived and the trees are shedding their leaves. Please take care on the paths in the school grounds – they can be slippery first thing in the morning.

### **HEADLICE**

The half term holiday is a good time to thoroughly check and treat your children's hair. If everybody carried out a bug busting check and returned to school headlice free, this would help us through the Christmas half term.

In order to carry out bug busting, the best procedure is as follows:

- \* Wash the hair as normal using an ordinary shampoo.
- \* Apply conditioner liberally to wet hair (this causes the lice to lose their grip on the hair).
- \* Comb the hair through with a normal comb first.
- \* With a fine tooth nit comb, comb from the roots along the complete length of the hair and after each stroke check the comb for lice and wipe it clean. Work methodically over the whole head for at least 30 minutes.
- \* Rinse hair as normal.
- \* Repeat every three days over the week.

### **KINGS' CLUB**

A new after school club will be starting at school on Monday 10<sup>th</sup> November, 3.20pm – 4.15pm. At "Kings' Club" the children will play games, sing songs, do craft activities and hear stories about Jesus. It is open to all children in Key Stage 2.
