### Curriculum Committee

#### Terms of Reference

**Title:** The Curriculum Committee

**Membership:**

- a. Membership shall consist of not less than four governors.
- b. The committee shall have such co-opted non-governor non-voting/voting members as the governing body shall appoint. The committee will make recommendations for these appointments, which should include such staff as the Headteacher shall determine in consultation with his colleagues.

**Quorum:** The quorum shall be three governors.

**Meetings:** The committee shall meet once per term or otherwise as required.

**Terms of Reference:**

- i To advise the governing body on the school's secular curriculum policy and their statutory obligations regarding the National Curriculum.
- ii With the assistance of the staff to provide information to the full governing body about how the curriculum is taught, evaluated and resourced.
- iii To review the policy and provision for collective worship and for Religious Education and make recommendations to the full governing body.
- iv To review the policy and provision for sex education and make recommendations to the full governing body.
- v To ensure that the requirements of children with special needs are met through establishing and monitoring an SEN policy.
- vi To review information and data about school performance.
- vii To set and agree targets for pupil achievement at Key Stage 2.
- viii To contribute towards the school improvement plan.
- ix To agree on a policy and protocol for governor visits to the school.
